ENGLISH LANGUAGE



GENERAL ENGLISH

Our General English classes will help you improve your overall English ability. Your confidence will grow through lessons targeting your pronunciation, grammar, and vocabulary.

This class builds on your existing knowledge to help you to communicate freely or prepare you for an academic or work-related programme. Suitable for learners of any level, our fun and engaging approach to teaching will make sure that you progress quickly and easily.

IELTS EXAM PREPARATION

These exams are recognised worldwide as proof of English for academic purposes. IELTS is used for visa requirements in many countries.

You will develop the English language skills and exam techniques necessary to prepare for the IELTS exams. Our preparation programme focuses on your goals, helping you develop strategies to achieve a better score.

You will take weekly practice tests and have regular meetings to see how you're doing with the class.

TOEFL IBT EXAM PREPARATION

UNIVERSITY PATHWAY PROGRAMMES

ENGLISH LANGUAGE

The University Pathway Programme (UPP) course is designed to prepare you for university life in Canada or the UK, giving you an in-depth look at what they expect.

You'll develop the key skills required for studying in English at an undergraduate or postgraduate level, as well as receive regular assessments and feedback to help you succeed.

Depending on the university, this programme can be a substitute for an external English language exam such as IELTS.

You will:

- Focus on academic skills including essay writing, research methods, and critical thinking
- Prepare for independent academic study at an Englishspeaking university
- note-taking, reading, and summarising • Learn how to deliver an
 - academic presentation
- Improve your study, research, and critical thinking skills

This programme is also useful for students who already have a place at a university, or who want to keep their options open but still wish to prepare for studying in an English-speaking country.

GERMAN LANGUAGE

This programme will make sure you are ready to study at a university in Germany. You'll learn the academic and language skills you need for success at an undergraduate or postgraduate level. You will also receive regular assessment and feedback to help you achieve your goals.

The course is suitable for both direct and indirect access students, as it will prepare you for the TELC C1 university exam, TestDaf or for the Studdienkolleg entrance exam for your one year foundation course.

You will:

- Focus on academic skills including essay writing and critical thinking
- Prepare for independent academic study at a Germanspeaking university
- Practice listening to lectures, note-taking, reading, and summarising
- Learn how to deliver an academic presentation



These classes ensure personal attention as they are just you and the teacher. This means the whole lesson focuses on meeting your goals and addressing your specific needs, which we will identify with you.
